Communication and Language
- The children will be continually developing their language skills through play and interaction - They will be exposed to new books to support language development - The children will be doing news to support development in language as well as in personal, social and emotional development
Phonics
- The children will be learning phase 3 letter sounds - The children will be starting to blend and segment using phase 2 and 3 sounds - Please help your child by reading daily
Maths
- We will be comparing and representing 1, 2 and 3 and then to 5 - The children will be looking at circles, triangles and squares as well as positional language - We will be learning about one more and one less
Science
- The children will be talking about Autumn and looking at seasonal change - They will explore the weather changes from Autumn to Winter - We will be looking at changes of state in relation to freezing and melting
Art/ D.T
- Our artist of the half term is Vincent van Gogh and the children will be looking at 'The Poppy Field' with links to Remembrance Day. They will be creating their own Poppy paintings as well as doing some firework pictures - The children will be designing 3D models of their homes and making Christmas cards
Music
- The children will be singing and enjoying familiar songs and rhymes linked to rhyming and number - We will be starting to use our 'Jolly Music' lessons to talk about pitch
History
- The children will be thinking about their own family traditions celebrated at home - We will be remembering people who have helped us with a link to Remembrance Day
Geography
- The children will be learning about where they live and local places around them - We will be comparing our homes with homes around the world

PSHE
- The children will be talking about celebrating difference - This will link into our traditions and festivals of other people - The children will talk about the importance of accepting others
RE
- Our topic this half term in Discovery RE is 'Christmas' and we are linking this to 'Incarnation' through our 'Understanding Christianity' teaching - Children will be talking about giving presents and saying thank you as well as learning about the birth of Jesus
