## Must have knowledge

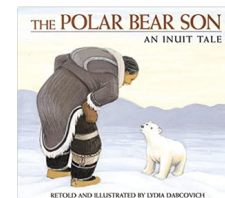
We will be using maps and pictures to help us to learn the following key facts:
