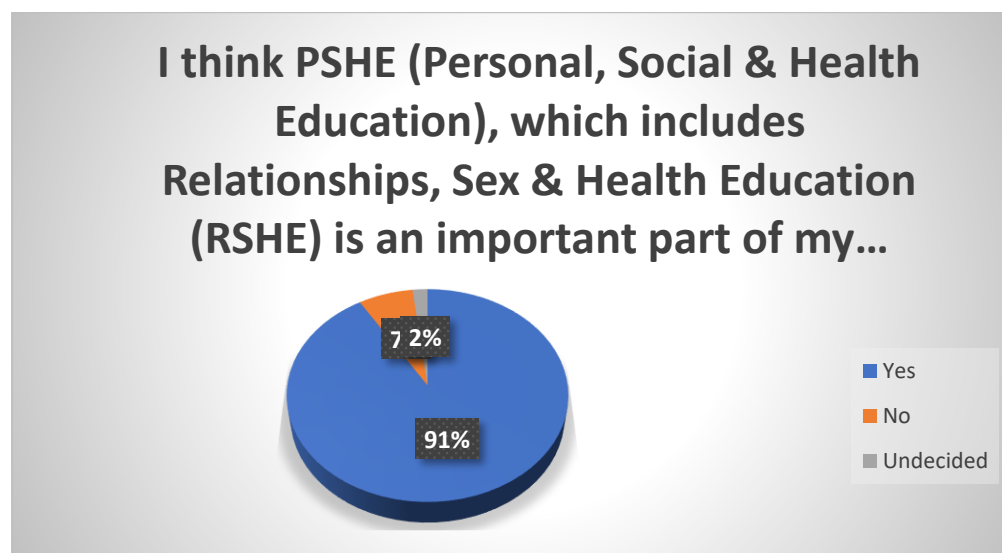

As part of our PSHE curriculum we use the Jigsaw scheme of work from Early Years to Year Two. Statutory relationships and health education and non-statutory sex education are integral to Jigsaw.

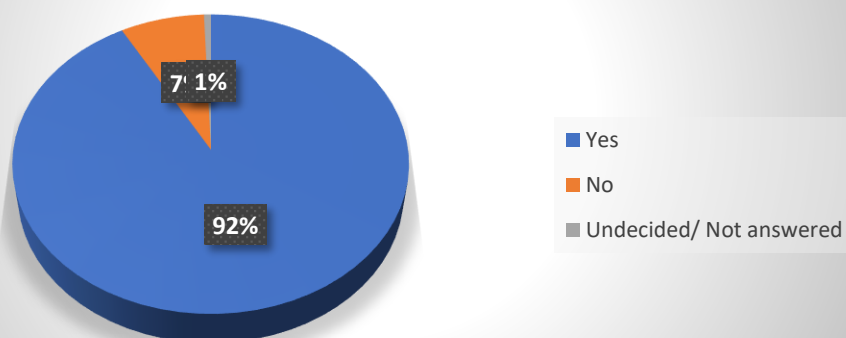

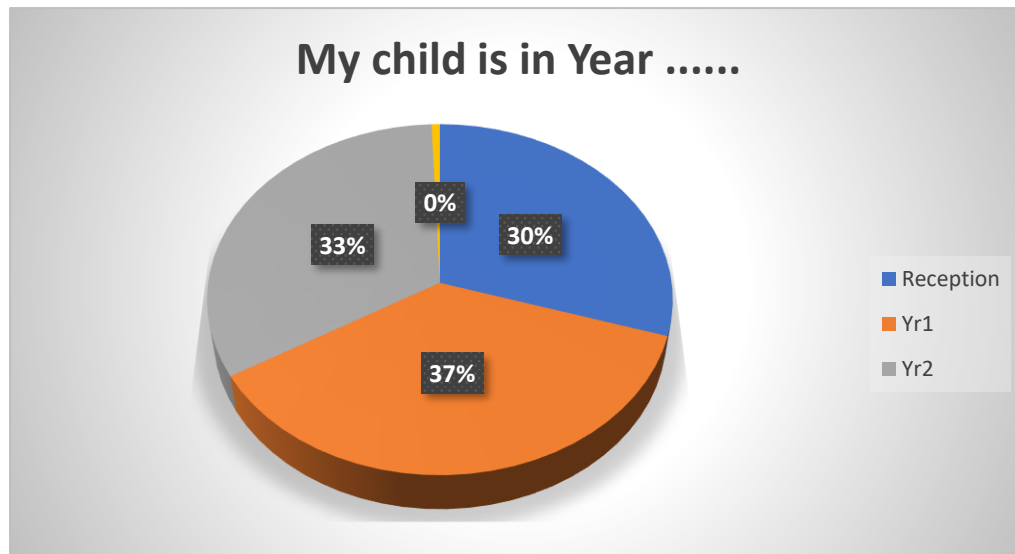
